



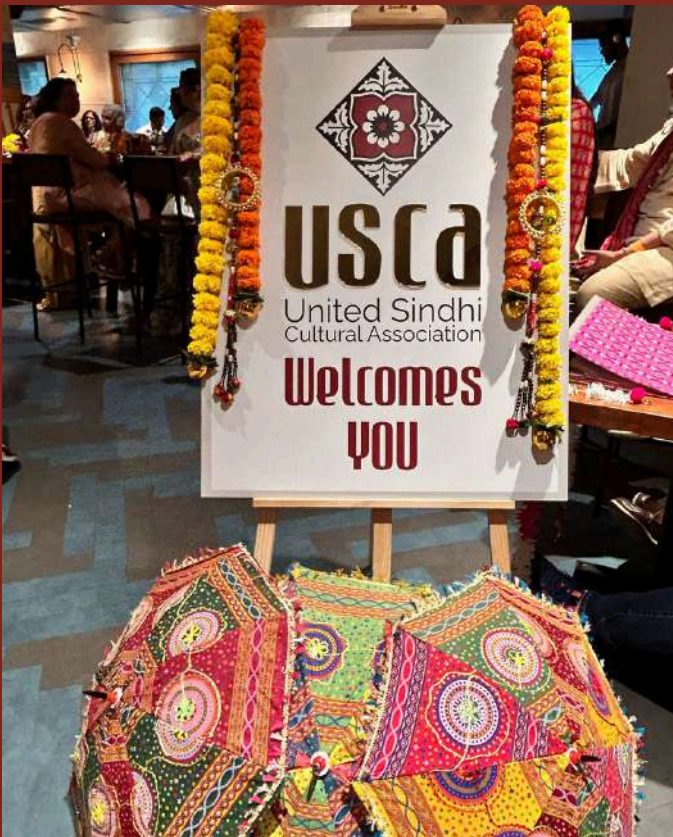

USCA's Online Sindhi Conversation Classes, led by Ms. Kajal Ramchandani, have become a warm and engaging space for learners of all ages.

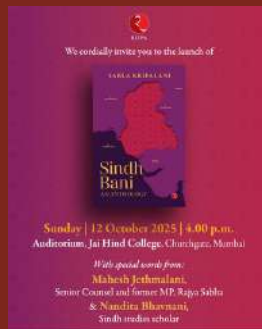

## USCA CARES!



In the remote tribal villages of Maroshi in Murbad Taluka, nearly 200 undernourished children and pregnant mothers rely on vital nutritional support to grow stronger and healthier.

Welfare Society For Destitute Children, St Catherine of Siena, has been working tirelessly to ensure that those most vulnerable receive regular medical check-ups and specially curated nutrition kits to support healthy development. Last year, the program was expanded to include expecting mothers, recognizing that good nourishment during pregnancy can help ensure healthier children and brighter futures.

However, with donor support dwindling, this critical initiative faces challenges. In the spirit of Diwali, **United Sindhi Cultural Association (USCA)** stepped forward and contributed 25 nutrition kits to families in need. Each kit contained essential food items such as dal, jaggery, groundnuts, oil, poha, tea, and spices – simple but impactful supplies that help sustain health and dignity.

This gesture is a reminder that even small acts can create meaningful change. We remain committed to supporting similar efforts and invite more well-wishers to join us in continuing this essential lifeline of nourishment and care.

This Diwali, USCA took an important step toward improving the health and well-being of tribal communities living in Kalyan and nearby villages.

With generous contributions from our donors, we were able to support 150 children who are suffering from malnutrition by providing them with essential multivitamins for the entire year. Recognizing that the health of a child is closely linked to the wellbeing of the mother, USCA extended support to the mothers of these children through the same supplementation program.

This initiative was carried out in collaboration with the India Relief Foundation, whose ongoing fieldwork and medical guidance ensured that the supplements reached the families who need them most. Regular monitoring and support from local health workers will help track progress and ensure that this nutritional intervention has a lasting impact.

While this is a small step in addressing a much larger challenge, it is one that nurtures hope, dignity, and healthier futures.
