

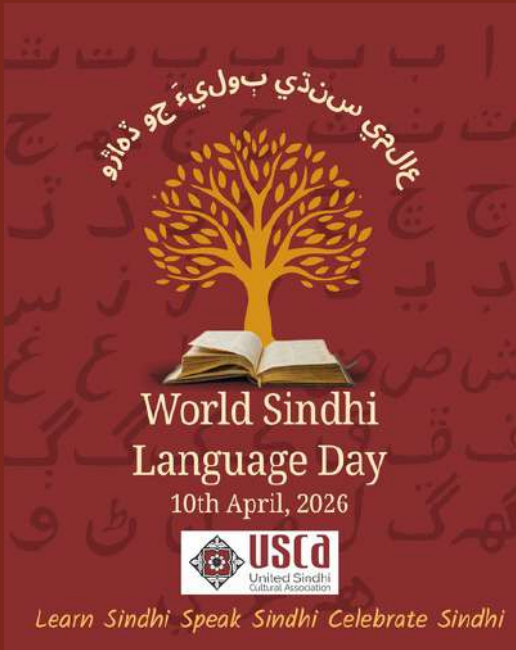

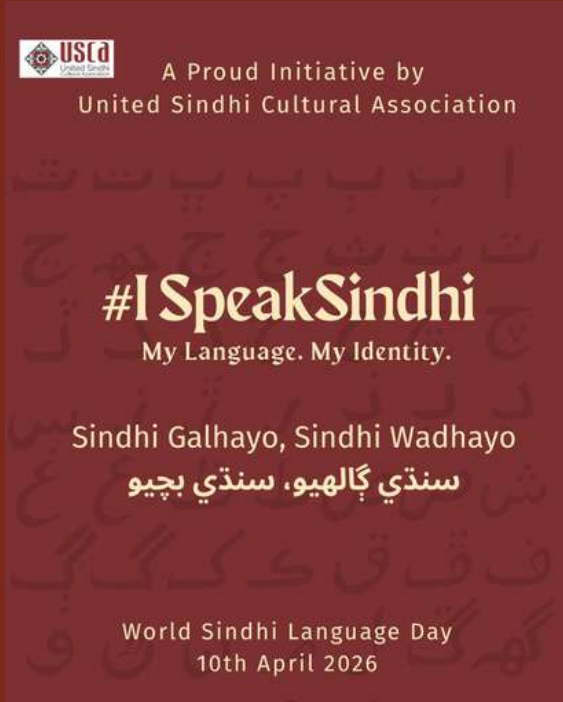


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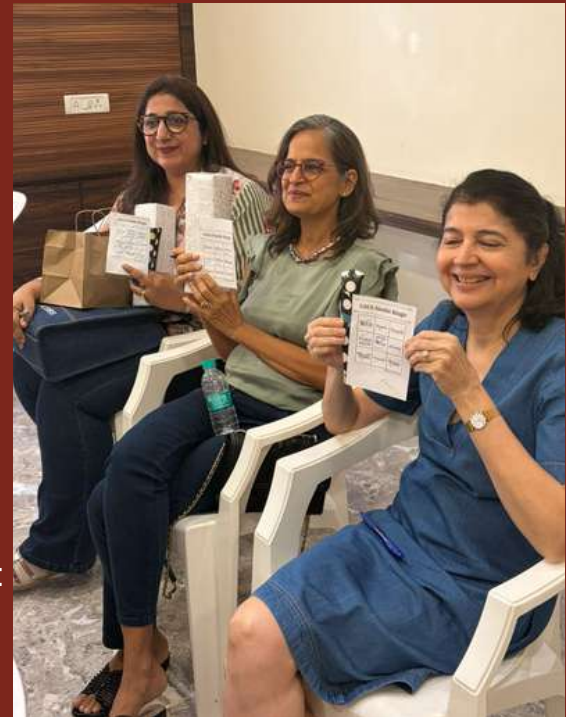
USCA Celebrates World Sindhi Day 2026

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Breast Cancer Screening Camp 2.0



On 16th April 2026, the United Sindhi Cultural Association (USCA), in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Bombay Pier and Nana Palkar Smruti Samiti, organised a Breast Cancer Screening Camp near Somani Garden, Cuffe Parade.

The camp was conducted with the objective of creating awareness about the importance of early detection and providing access to preventive healthcare for women who may not otherwise have the opportunity to undergo regular screening. The beneficiaries included women from the neighbouring slum communities as well as the dedicated police personnel from the Cuffe Parade Police Station.



The medical team from Nana Palkar Smruti Samiti conducted the screenings with professionalism, compassion and care, while also educating participants about breast health, self-examination and the importance of timely medical intervention.

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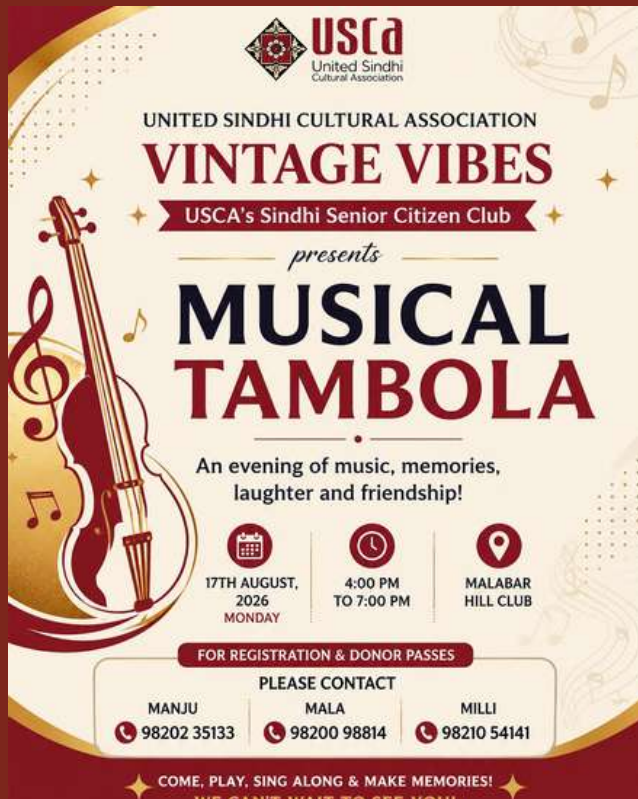
